
TRAINING ENDORSEMENT POLICY

The London Chapter is frequently asked to endorse training courses (including conferences, workshops and on-line provision) to its membership. This policy is to ensure consistency and fairness of treatment to all such applications.

- 1) The Chapter will **not** endorse any Third Party training courses. The Chapter will only **recommend** its own products, and those offered by ISACA International.
- 2) The Chapter may **draw the attention** of its membership to other products dependent on the provider meeting one, or more, of the following criteria:
 - a) Academic training provided by an institution, or validated by an institution, listed as being authorised to do so by the Department for Education and Skills (DfES), or
 - b) Professional training provided by institutions which have an evidenced track record for providing quality tuition, or
 - c) Professional training provided by institutions without a track record, but which have supplied a programme which appears to be of interest to ISACA members and which contains speakers with an evidenced reputation within the field of information systems audit, Information systems security and/or IT governance.
- 3) For commercial courses the Chapter will always seek advantageous terms for ISACA members.
- 4) The Chapter may accept paid-for advertising for training courses which do not meet the above criteria, but this will be determined on an individual basis following review and approval by the Chapter Board, or its delegated representative(s). Such advertisements will always carry a disclaimer such as that used on the Chapter web site.
